Monthly writing activity details:

You receive a prompt (word/ sentence/ image...) every month and you write something in response!

Sharing circle details:

Meeting time: 7.30pm last Wednesday of every month

FAQs:

- 1) **Is there a writing allowance?** Yes, between 100-200 words.
- 2) **Can I write in any format?** Yes- prose, poetry, lyrics, script writing, description to an image/ video that you have created/ found, any other format that you have discovered while invigilating the Arbus exhibition
- 3) **Is a response that is non-writing based allowed?** The response should be writing based in some capacity, so even if your response is a photo/ painting/ video etc, write a piece of text to go with it. Who knows, it could bring out the hidden Haruki Murakami/ Agatha Christie in you.
- 4) **Can I attend the sharing circle having not written anything?** Yes you can. Come and have a chat about what others have written! You never know what it might inspire in you...
- 5) **Does the response have to include the prompt word in it?** Not at all
- 6) **Do I have to contribute every month?** You don't ever have to do anything you don't want to. In any case, feel free to write every month, once and never again or never at all.
- 7) **Will I be able to read the submissions online?** Yes they will be uploaded to the facebook group. Let me/ Katy H know if you'd like to be added to it!
- 8) **How does one even feedback?** There will be feedback prompts printed out on the day of the sharing circle.
- 9) **Can I write more than one submission per prompt?** Of course.
- 10) **Is there anything else you can persuade me to write?** In the words of Tolstoy: Happiness is an allegory, unhappiness is a story.
